In 1969 Emile Vuistiner bought this century-old Brasserie, formerly called le Café de la Gare in reference to the old « Ficelle » the first cable car in Switzerland, converted in 1958 in a rack railway and in 2008 in Métro M2.

This Vaudois by adoption, born in Canton Valais, has been operating the restaurant since more than 40 years.

After his death in 2010, his daughter and stepson, Nathalie et Stéphane Porchet decided to continue the business in the same spirit to perpetuate the tradition.

More that 50 years later, the family is still continuing the exploitation of this authentic local Brasserie which obtained in May 2022 the label «Historical Café of Lausanne».
